REGULAR MEETING, June 16, 2020, 7:00 P.M.

The Regular Meeting of the Stroud Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairwoman & Secretary, Christine A. Wilkins at 7:07 P.M., for a live and virtual on-line meeting of the Board. Public Comments: (Non-Agenda Items) There were no Public Comments.
