REGULAR MEETING, July 21, 2020, 7:00 P.M.

The Regular Meeting of the Stroud Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairwoman & Secretary, Christine A. Wilkins at 7:07 P.M., for a live and virtual on-line meeting of the Board. Also present were Vice Chairwoman & Ass't Secretary, Jennifer Shukaitis; Supervisor/Ass't Treasurer Edward C. Cramer; Township Manager, Daryl A. Eppley; Township Solicitor, Todd Weitzmann; and Recording Secretary, Janice Willey.

Public Comments: (Non-Agenda Items) There were no Public Comments.

Manager's Report: Mr. Eppley reported another round for the MultiModal Grant has been approved and still waiting on where we stand with our other grants. The Green Light Go Grant has been put on hold, the pandemic has hurt the funding for that project. However, Senator Scavello is looking to utilize another grant to do a four way intersection improvement at Rimrock Drive and get turning lanes there to tie in with the traffic lights at Giant on Route 611 since that is main area for bottle necking. Our Safety Committee had a kickoff meeting last week and will have the first official meeting starting in August and then quarterly. The 2019 Financial Audit is almost complete. The golf course has been doing well but Dustin McCormick discussed not opening the suites for Stay and Play due to the pandemic, if that was ok with the Board. Park Patrol has noticed increased usage at the parks, from walkers, to dog walkers and fishermen. This weekend there was a big surge from nonresidents looking for water sources to cool off, which caused parking issues on Mill Creek Road.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: **Month of June.** Mr. Eppley read the Treasurer's Report aloud. Ms. Shukaitis made a motion to <u>accept the Treasurer's Report for the month of June.</u> Mr. Cramer seconded. All voted aye, motion carried 3-0.

<u>Public Works Dept. Report</u>: Road Crew finished paving Hammond Lane, Roosevelt Street from Mill Creek Road to Yetter Park. They fixed the intersection at Arbor Way and Wigwam Park Road. They replaced the storm pipe at Westbury Drive and Mohawk Trail and replaced 2 pipes at Shady Tree Drive and Brookfield Lane. Our road side mowers are out and trimming back for sight distance. And they are always working hard on the "Request for Action" forms as they come in.

<u>Police Report</u>: Captain Gasper reported after a long investigation there has been an arrest in the fatal car crash at four lane Route 209. If there were any he said please feel free to contact him.

<u>Solicitor's Report</u>: Mr. Weitzmann reported there was a hearing scheduled this past week regarding a Short Term Rental. The Defendant showed up stating he does not speak English and did not make arrangements to have an interpreter. So it will be pushed back to a later date.

<u>Engineer's Report</u>: Mr. Eppley stated he had Mrs. Alker's report and many of the items are things she is still working on. One new item was DMAP, regarding deer management and coupons that were received to distribute starting in October to archery hunters.

<u>Fire Department Report</u>: No one there to report.
