MEETING MINUTES

August 20, 2024, at 7:00 P.M.

The Regular Meeting of the Stroud Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairwoman & Secretary, Jennifer Shukaitis at 7:00 P.M., Also present were Vice Chairman & Ass't. Treasurer, Edward Cramer; Supervisor/Ass't. Secretary, Susan Lyons; Township Manager, Daryl A. Eppley; Township Engineer, Chris McDermott, of Reilly Associates; Township Solicitor, Todd Weitzmann; and Recording Secretary, Janice Willey. Ms. Shukaitis began the meeting with the pledge of allegiance.

Public Comments: (Non-Agenda Items) There were none.

Treasurer's Report: Month of July, 2024. Ms. Lyons made a motion to <u>accept the Treasurer's Report for the Month of July, 2024.</u> Mr. Cramer seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried 3-0.

Manager's Report: Mr. Eppley reported the project consultant on the Mervine Road bridge project has reviewed the draft reimbursement request and has offered a few suggestions. The contractor for the Green Light-Go project on Route 611 is still waiting for modems from PennDOT. Preliminary engineering by American Engineers Group continues on the Lessig Lane bridge project and Croasdale Road bridge replacement projects. A preliminary Lessig Lane bridge design to review is expected to be received in the next few weeks. A pavement markings bid has been readvertised and bids are due 8/29/2024 by 11:00 A.M. An on-line meeting was held with BCRA and Stroud Recreation to discuss the dog park at Brodhead Creek Park. The parks and golf course have been busy. PennDOT posted a Shafers Schoolhouse Road and four-lane 209 project description that we can link to our Facebook page. A plan shows final configuration. Construction activity resumed on PennDOT's Glenbrook Road bridge. The budget/finance committee has started work on the 2025 SARPD budget.

<u>Public Works Dept. Report</u>: Mr. Eppley read Josh Cramer's report, The work is completed on the Albertson gazebo roof. MS-4 projects on Vanvliet Road and Progress Street have been completed. The FB3 paving project in Northgate Development is complete and fog seal to be completed mid-September. Chip seal on Middle Road and Poplar Valley Road East is complete and line striping to be done in the next few weeks. The Road Crew has been busy cleaning up after recent storms. They are working on drainage issues. Craig Coslar, township mechanic built a new spillway guard to replace broken one at Albertson Park pond. And we have been busy working on Request for Action slips.

<u>Police Report</u>: Captain Raymond summarized their report and asked if there were any questions from the board. There were none.

Solicitor's Report: Mr. Weitzmann did not have anything to report.

Engineer's Report: Mr. McDermott updated the board on I&I projects, on-going MS4 projects, there are a few Plan Review updates and summarized on-going projects throughout the township.
