Wilkins at 7:00 P.M., at the Stroud Township Municipal Center, 1211 North Fifth Street, Stroudsburg, Pa. Also present were Vice Chairman/Ass't Public Works Superintendent, Patrick L. Briegel; Township Manager, Daryl A. Eppley; Township Solicitor, Todd Weitzmann; and Recording Secretary, Janice Willey.

Manager's Report: Mr. Eppley reported they are working on the access control installation for the municipal building. The progress continues on the police budget and should be ready by the first week in October. A meeting is desired by the Sewer Authority for Stroudsburg, Stroud Township and Pocono Township to discuss flows into the wastewater treatment plant. Requests for proposal for auditing services has been advertised and are due on October 10, 2019 by 4 p.m. The Mervine Bridge replacement project will start next Thursday. Residents have been notified. He will be meeting with two firms vying to be the consultant for the update to the Hamilton-Pocono-Stroudsburg Multi-Municipal Comprehensive Plan. PennDot is now working on Glenbrook Road on the stream side shoulder. He attended a meeting with PennDOT, who is planning on repaving Route 447 from the signal at Marshalls Creek exit to Route 447/191 signal next spring.

Public Works Dept. Report: Douglas Walker, Public Works Superintendent, reported the Road Crew has been working on many projects. Lockwood Circle project is now complete. It was ripped up and repaved. They have been out patching roads in the Township. We are getting ready for the Mervine Bridge Replacement project with the temporary and all the prep that goes with that. Midlantic is scheduled for Thursday for line painting. They have been responding to "Request for Action" forms as they come in and trying to keep on top of them now that the season is changing.

Police Report: Officer Scott Raymond reported the department has been using NRAD, a speed timing device in different parts of the township and other municipalities. Certain roads are problem areas that they are focusing on. As far as robberies, there hasn't been any in Stroud Township or other municipalities until today. There was one today in the Borough of Stroudsburg and he feels it's necessary to bring up as a warning to keep an eye out and be aware. He asked if there are any questions or concerns. Mr. Eppley asked if Fifth Street can be monitored during travel times for school buses. He has noticed speeding cars during these times. Officer Raymond said he can be contacted if there are any other questions or concerns.

Solicitor's Report: Nothing to report.

Engineer's Report: Mrs. Alker reported she's doing follow up work on ongoing land development projects. And she was notified they will start paving the accessible parking spaces and walkways at the ESU Fields.

Fire Department Report: No one there to report.
