Re Ordinance No. 2-2020 Relating To The Use And Regulation Of Short-Term Rental Units Within The Township And Establishing Application And Permit Standards And Procedures, Providing For Administration And Enforcement Including Penalties, And Other Matters Pertaining Thereto And Ordinance No. 3-2020 Amending Chapter 27 (Zoning) Of The Stroud Township Code Of Ordinances, To Provide For A New Short Term Rental Overlay District, To Describe That New District's Intent And Purpose, To Amend The Official Zoning Map, And To Eliminate References To "Tourist Home.".

The Public Hearing of the Stroud Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairwoman & Secretary, Christine A. Wilkins at 7:00 P.M., for a virtual on-line and live meeting of the Board.
