New Business:

- 1. Discuss UGI Utilities Gas Line Extension In Township Right-Of-Ways. Mr. Eppley explained the UGI project and how it might affect the Sewer Authority and the Township. He also suggested Mr. Weitzmann review Ordinance 3-1998, which was referenced in the UGI Road Cutting permit. Mr. Cramer suggested increasing the fees after reviewing the Ordinance. Mr. Weitzamnn said he will review the Ordinance and will report back to the Board.
- 2. Personnel Matter. Mr. Eppley suggested going into Executive session to discuss Personnel Matter.
